Policy and Procedure Chair Report

Dear Chair Brown and Commissioners:

The Policy and Procedure Committee met on May 24, with Commissioners Farah, Foroozan and Singleton present.

ONGOING BUSINESS

1. Mental Health Response Study

The Committee discussed an upcoming interjurisdictional meeting with parties interested in establishing a co-responder model. Commissioner Singleton indicated she would work with Commissioner Westphal, Ryan Patrick, and community members to begin working out details of the MPD workgroup.

2. Review of MPD Policy and Procedure Manual

Commissioner Singleton explained that she and OPCR staff are working to determine the scope of the National Initiative's policy review. Once that is known, Commissioner Singleton will work with OPCR staff and Commander Case to create a review plan that will not duplicate the National Initiative efforts.

3. Framework for the Chief's Performance Review

Commissioner Foroozan reported that he will have a draft rubric prepared to present at the June Policy & Procedure Committee meeting.

4. Issue Tracking Queue

The Committee added the two cases referred to the Policy & Procedure Committee to the issue tracking queue: [Case # 16-03-03](#), under de-escalation; and [Case # 16-04-07](#), involving enforcement of bicycling laws.

NEW BUSINESS

1. New Projects

Committee members reviewed the queue and will be prepared to propose new projects at the June Policy & Procedure meeting. Commissioner Farah requested that Mr. Patrick investigate having a follow-up presentation on the School Resource Officer program.
