****Update Regarding the City Council:***

The Public Safety Committee did not take any significant action regarding the MPD. To my knowledge, Chief Harteau has not taken any action regarding the MPD's preliminary body camera policy. As a reminder, the PCOC body camera forum will be held Saturday, May 14 from 10 a.m. to Noon. A draft agenda for the forum is attached to this report.

****Update Regarding the Civil Rights Commission:***

The MCCR proved to be an excellent ally to the PCOC regarding our body camera forum. They are fully supportive of our recommended policy and are partnering with us at the body camera forum.

Commissioner Khan-Schwartz and I are continuing work on the MN/EDP project. In the next two weeks we will be meeting with the 911 Dispatchers and DC Rondo to discuss the protocol used for service calls involving mental health issues.
