

W&M - Your Committee, having under consideration a recommendation from the Executive Committee to establish a Paid Parental Leave Policy, now recommends the following:


- a) Approval of a Paid Parental Leave policy that will provide up to three weeks (120 hours) of paid parental leave to eligible employees following the birth or adoption of a child, as more fully set forth in Petition No. 278326 on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
- b) Direct the Human Resources Department to develop and put into place the necessary procedures that will support the implementation of a Paid Parental Leave Policy, to be effective January 1, 2015. Further, staff is directed to identify and provide a mechanism to make whole those employees that claim a qualifying event that occurred after January 1, 2015.
- c) Direct the Human Resources Department to place the policy and procedures in the City's Policy Library.
