**Subject:**

Joint Powers Agreement with the State of Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the Minneapolis Emergency Communications Center.

**Description:**

Passage of Resolution authorizing a Joint Powers Agreement between the Minneapolis Emergency Communications Center and the State of Minnesota's Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) granting MECC access to use the systems and tools available over the State's Criminal Justice Data communications Network (CJDN) for which the City is eligible.
