




Minneapolis Census Participation Rate(*) by Census Tract










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


Distribution of 7-County Metro Area Non-White Population, 2000

Non-White Population = 444,430




Distribution of 7-County Metro Area Non-White Population, 2010

Non-White Population = 676,349




Percent People of Color, 2010




7-County Metro Area Population by Race and Ethnicity 2000




7-County Metro Area Population by Race and Ethnicity 2010



Housing Units: More Units, More Vacancies


- Total housing units increased, but so did vacant units


2000 to 2010 Percent Change in Population




Population Change by Neighborhood 2000-2010




Neighborhood Housing Unit Change 2000-2010




Neighborhood Housing Unit Vacancy 2010



2010 MPRB Commissioner District Population and Variation from Average


2010 Percent Variation from Average




2000 and 2010 Race and Ethnicity





Two or More Races



