- 1) Smith_image01.jpg : **"Tree of Life"**, 2015. Steel, ceramic and found objects. Minnetonka Center for the Arts, Orono, MN. 7' x 3' x 3' Budget \$3,000 A totem sculpture that incorporates welded metal portions of a tree trunk and branches supporting ceramic animals, inspired by a trip to Africa and representing how everything supports each other.
- 2) Smith_image02.jpg : **"Forever Blooms"**, 2014. Steel and found objects. Private Residence Duluth, MN , 4' x 2' x 2', Budget \$1,000. This work is a large metal flower made from found gears and silverware meant for display in a private garden to provide rusty blooms all year long.
- 3) Smith_image03.jpg : **"Rising Up"**, 2011. Photograph, silver-gelatin print. Cameron Art Museum Wilmington, NC. 18" x24". A photograph depicting a woman rising up to from a failure, on display as part of the 2011 State of the Art/Art of the State show at the Cameron Art Museum.
- 4) Smith_image04.jpg : **"Boom"**, 2009. Steel, photographs, broken electronics and speakers. University of Minnesota – Twin Cities, 4' x 10' x 10', Student work. This indoor sculpture explored what is inside discarded electronics and visually exploding them to highlight the beautiful materials found inside.
- 5) Smith_image05.jpg : **"Impressions"**, 2008. Plaster and crafting supplies. University of Minnesota –Twin Cities, 4 5'x3' panels, Student Work. This project was exploring the stigma of art vs crafting, using common crafting supplies engulfed by plaster poured over tables, used for years to create "art" picking up the left over bits of art once removed, and revealing the impressions left from at the intersection of the two.
