### Being Part of the Scene Without Making a Scene

Thank you for coming downtown to enjoy one of the most energetic and interesting bar scenes in Minnesota. Please consider the following at bar closing:

- **Don't walk in the streets.**
- **Don't obstruct traffic.**
- **Don't cause disturbances.**

**These are not just suggestions...it's the law. MCO 385.65\*** Police will be increasing enforcement in these areas. Making a scene downtown could get you a ticket. Also, drawing attention to yourself makes you a better target for criminal activity, fights and theft as an example.

\*Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 385.65 states that no person, in any public or private place, shall use offensive, obscene or abusive language, or grab, follow or engage in conduct which reasonably tends to arouse alarm or anger in others, or walk, stand, sit, lie, or place an object in such a manner as to block passage by another person or a vehicle, or to require another person or a driver of a vehicle to take evasive action to avoid physical contact.
